



Set in one of the most picturesque landscape frames in the world, the Tuscan hills, a natural and unique crossroads of history, art and culture, Villa Rospigliosi, ideally located between Pistoia, Florence and Lucca, a few kilometers from Vinci, the birthplace of Leonardo, is among the historical residences of excellence in Tuscany.

The Villa takes its name from Cardinal Giulio Rospigliosi, Pope Clement IX from 1667 to 1669, who during his brief pontificate commissioned its design to the most renowned architect of the time: Gian Lorenzo Bernini.

However, Pope Clement IX did not have time to live there because he died the same year in which the works began. Nevertheless the project was completed and the Villa was used by the Rospigliosi family as a summer residence until the early twentieth century.

Restored to its former glory by recent restoration works, Villa Rospigliosi hosts the homonymous and prestigious musical competition since 26 years.

### REGULATIONS

- The competition is open to young musicians of any nationality. Art. 1
- The aim of the competition is that of promoting musical culture, Art. 2 encourage young people to study music.
- The Chamber Music International Competition will take place Art. 3 between 13 - 14 March 2024 at Villa Rospigliosi in Lamporecchio (Pistoia-Tuscany).
- The exhibitions will be open to the public and will be divided into the Art. 4 following categories. The competition is aimed at any instrumental and/or vocal groups, including piano duets. Contestants are free to enter one repertoire, provided they comply with the maximum timelimits:

Cat. A	born after 2010	10 minutes
Cat. B	born after 2007	15 minutes
Cat. C	born after 2005	20 minutes
Cat. D	from 20 years upwards	
	without any age limit	30 minutes

- The category will be determined by the average age of the components in Art. 5 a given group.
- All contestants can register for higher categories if they believe they are Art. 6 sufficiently well prepared. The absolute winners may not participate in the same category in which they have already won. When citing the competition in their curriculum, winners are required to specify correctly the prize they have won as well as the name of the Rospigliosi Competition.
- The organization will provide only a piano; the candidates must come Art. 7 with their own music stand and all the instruments and/or accessories they need for their performance.
- Transcriptions from solo concerts will not be accepted under any Art. 8 circumstances.
- The contestants will perform listened to in alphabetical order, starting Art. 9 from the letter that is extracted by the artistic committee of the competition.
- Art. 10 Upon arrival, the contestants must present: 1) a form of identification to the competition secretary's office 2) one copy of the pieces they plan to play to the jury
- It is not obligatory to perform from memory. Art. 11
- Art. 12 The organization reserves the right to modify this announcement and to abolish a category if the number of contestants is deemed to be insufficient. Only in this case, the registration fee will be refunded. Furthermore, the organization will not assume any liability for risks or damages of any nature that might be incurred by the contestants throughout the performance.
- The results will be announced at the end of the auditions of each Art. 13 category.
- Art. 14 Any recordings, live streaming, radio or television broadcasts of the performances will not entitle the performers to any compensation. Audio - video recordings by "Mulino del Ronzone Recording Studio" -SUONAMIDITE OdV Association

Art. 19 The Jury will be made up of lecturers at the academy of music (Conservatorio) and by prominent persons in the world of music. Members of the Jury are not permitted to present their own students. The following Maestros have given their availability:
